



## **69Express: Southbound U.S. 69 segment will be fully closed overnight March 10**

All southbound U.S. 69 lanes from 119<sup>th</sup> Street to Blue Valley Parkway and the 119<sup>th</sup> Street to southbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp in Overland Park will be **fully closed** to traffic overnight from:

- 5 p.m. Sunday, March 10 to 6 a.m. Monday, March 11

Detours will be marked.

These temporary closures are necessary for paving operations for a portion of the new southbound U.S. 69 lanes between Antioch and Blue Valley Parkway and are part of the KDOT U.S. 69 Expansion Project (69Express). All scheduled project work is weather permitting and subject to change.

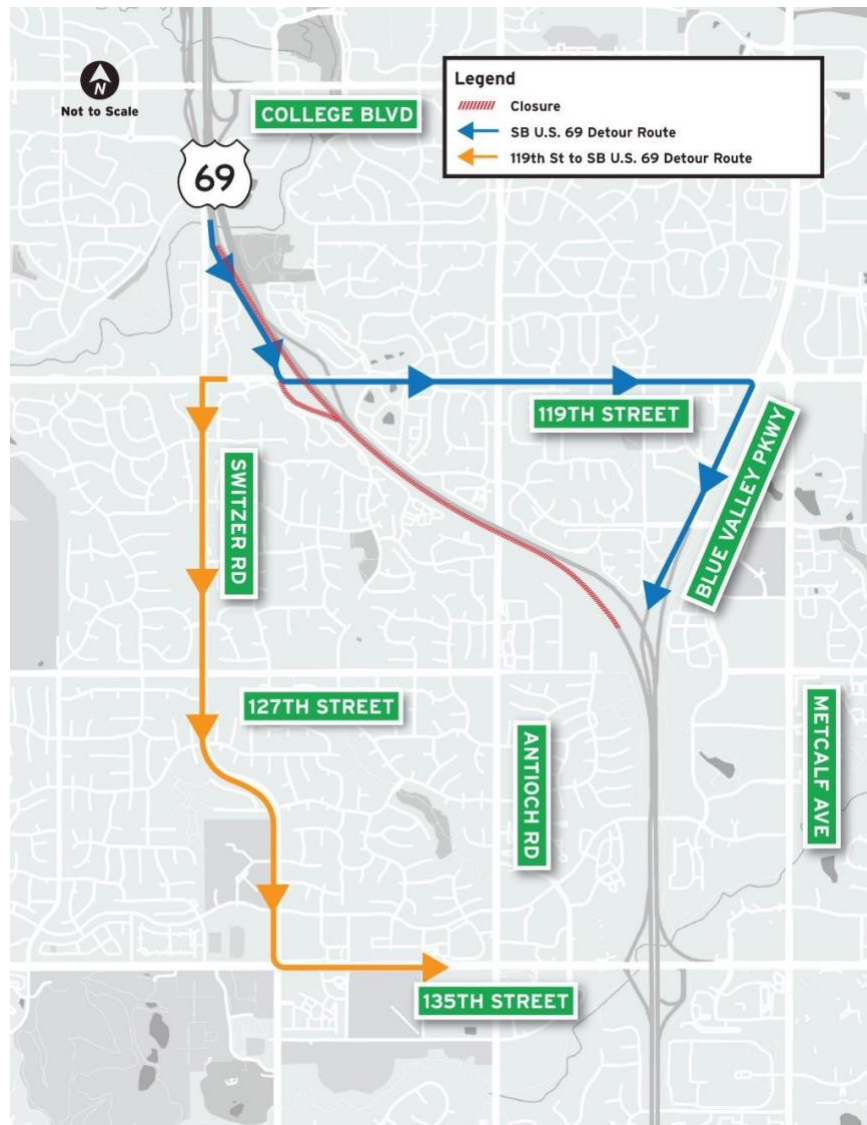
**During the closure, detours will be marked as follows:**

- **Southbound U.S. 69: traffic will be directed to exit at 119<sup>th</sup> Street and turn left onto 119<sup>th</sup> Street, then travel east to Blue Valley Parkway and turn right to travel south and use the Blue Valley Parkway to southbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp.**
- **119<sup>th</sup> Street to enter southbound U.S. 69: traffic will be directed to turn south onto Switzer Road, then turn left onto 135<sup>th</sup> Street to use the 135<sup>th</sup> Street to southbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp.**

The 69Express project includes reconstruction of U.S. 69, widening the highway with added express lanes – one in each direction between 151<sup>st</sup> and 103<sup>rd</sup> Streets – and interchange improvements at U.S. 69/167<sup>th</sup> Street in Overland Park.
