Southbound U.S. 69 segment to fully close overnight April 9, 10 and 11

All southbound U.S. 69 lanes from 119th Street to Blue Valley Parkway and the 119th Street to southbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp in Overland Park will be **fully closed** to traffic overnight from:

- 7 p.m. Tuesday, April 9 to 6 a.m. Wednesday, April 10
- 7 p.m. Wednesday, April 10 to 6 a.m. Thursday, April 11
- 7 p.m. Thursday, April 11 to 6 a.m. Thursday, April 12

These temporary closures are necessary for bridge work on the new Blue Valley Parkway to southbound U.S. 69 flyover entrance ramp and are part of the KDOT U.S. 69 Expansion Project (69Express). All scheduled project work is weather permitting and subject to change.

During the closure, detours will be marked as follows:

- **Southbound U.S. 69:** traffic will be directed to exit at 119th Street and turn left onto 119th Street, then travel east to Blue Valley Parkway and turn right to travel south and use the Blue Valley Parkway to southbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp.
- **119th Street to enter southbound U.S. 69:** traffic will be directed to turn south onto Switzer Road, then turn left onto 135th Street to use the 135th Street to southbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp.

The 69Express project includes reconstruction of U.S. 69, widening the highway with added express lanes – one in each direction between 151st and 103rd Streets – and interchange improvements at U.S. 69/167th Street in Overland Park.
