



## Two 119th Street ramps will close June 26 for 120 days in Overland Park

In Overland Park, the 119th Street to northbound U.S. 69 ramp and the southbound U.S. 69 to 119th Street ramp will be **fully closed** to traffic beginning the morning of Wednesday, June 26. The ramps will remain closed for four months as part of 69Express project improvements at the 119th Street and U.S. 69 interchange.

**During the closure, detours will be marked as follows:**

- **119th Street to northbound U.S. 69:**
  - **Westbound traffic will continue west until Quivira Road, turn right onto Quivira Road and head north to College Boulevard, turn right onto College Boulevard and head east toward U.S. 69. Utilize the eastbound College Boulevard to northbound U.S. 69 loop ramp.**
  - **Eastbound traffic will continue east until Antioch Road, turn left onto Antioch Road and head north to College Boulevard, turn left onto College Boulevard and head west toward U.S. 69. Utilize the westbound College Boulevard to northbound U.S. 69 ramp.**
- **Southbound U.S. 69 to 119th Street:**
  - **Continue south on U.S. 69 to the 135th Street exit, turn right onto 135th Street and head west to Antioch Road, turn right onto Antioch Road and head north to 119th Street.**

Starting in mid-August, all 119th Street ramps and 119th Street will be fully closed until October.

The work is part of the KDOT U.S. 69 Expansion Project (69Express). The 69Express project includes reconstruction of U.S. 69, widening the highway with added express lanes – one in each direction between 151st and 103rd Streets – and interchange improvements at U.S. 69/167th Street in Overland Park.
