



Full closure of 135th Street at U.S. 69 scheduled this weekend

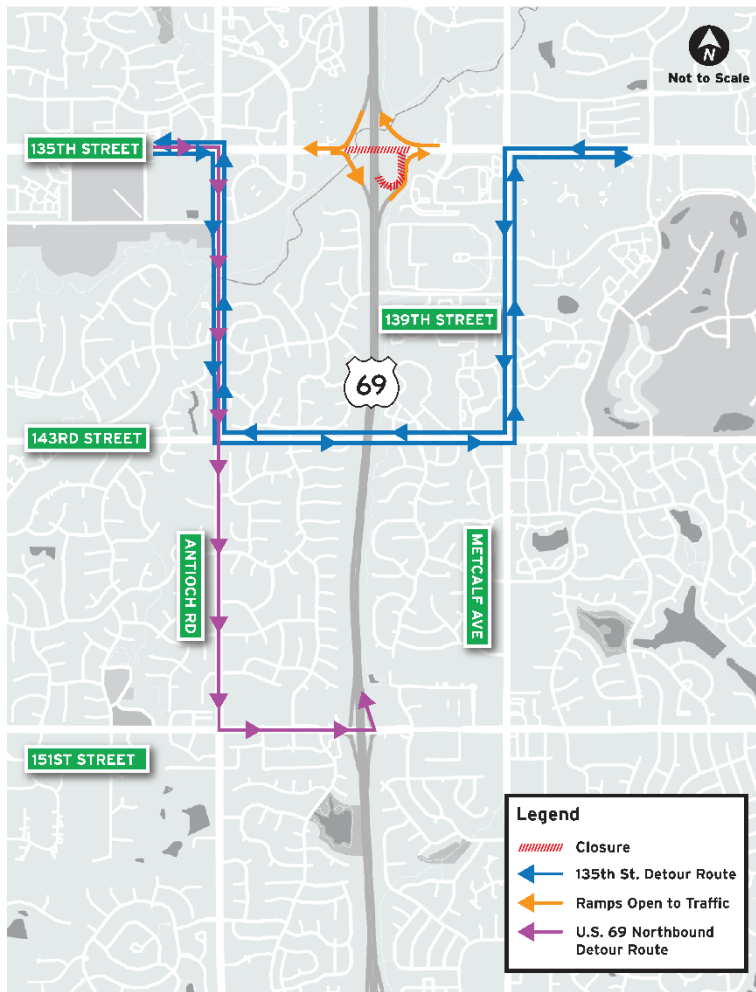

All lanes of 135th Street under U.S. 69 will be closed to traffic starting Friday, July 12 at 7 p.m. and will reopen by Monday, July 15 at 6 a.m.

This closure will allow a new box culvert to be installed for drainage under 135th Street. All 135th Street on and off ramps will remain accessible for right-turn only movements, except the eastbound 135th Street to northbound U.S. 69 loop ramp, which will be fully closed.

During the closure, traffic will be directed to detour as follows:

- **Traveling westbound on 135th Street: Turn south onto Metcalf Avenue. Travel southbound on Metcalf, then turn west onto 143rd Street. Travel westbound on 143rd Street, turn north on Antioch Road, then use Antioch to continue northbound to 135th Street.**
- **Traveling eastbound on 135th Street: Turn south onto Antioch Road. Travel southbound on Antioch, turn east on 143rd Street. Travel eastbound on 143rd Street, turn north on Metcalf Avenue, then use Metcalf to continue northbound to 135th Street.**
- **Traveling eastbound on 135th Street to northbound U.S. 69: Travel east on 135th Street and turn south on Antioch Road. Travel southbound on Antioch Road to 151st Street. Turn east on 151st Street and use the 151st Street on-ramp to northbound U.S. 69.**



All work is weather dependent and subject to change. These temporary closures are part of the Kansas Department of Transportation’s U.S. 69 expansion project (69Express).

The 69Express project includes reconstruction of U.S. 69, widening the highway with added express lanes – one in each direction between 151st and 103rd Streets – and interchange improvements at U.S. 69/167th Street in Overland Park.
