



U.S. 69 northbound ramp to 119th Street in Overland Park will close July 28 for 90 days

In Overland Park, the U.S. 69 northbound ramp to 119th Street will be **fully closed** to traffic beginning Sunday, July 28 at 5 p.m. The ramp will remain closed for three months as part of 69Express project improvements at the 119th Street and U.S. 69 interchange.

During the closure, detours will be marked as follows:

- **Northbound U.S. 69 to eastbound 119th Street traffic:** Continue north on U.S. 69 to College Blvd. Exit at College Blvd. and take College Blvd. east to Antioch Road. Turn right at Antioch Road and travel south to 119th Street.
- **Northbound U.S. 69 to westbound 119th Street traffic:** Continue north on U.S. 69 to College Blvd. Exit at College Blvd. and take College Blvd. west to Quivira Rd. Turn left at Quivira Rd. and travel south to 119th Street.

The 119th Street to northbound U.S. 69 and the southbound U.S. 69 to 119th Street ramps closed in late June. Starting in late August, all 119th Street ramps and 119th Street will be fully closed until late October.

The work is part of the KDOT U.S. 69 Expansion Project (69Express). The 69Express project includes reconstruction of U.S. 69, widening the highway with added express lanes – one in each direction between 151st and 103rd Streets – and interchange improvements at U.S. 69/167th Street in Overland Park.
