



Two Blue Valley Parkway Ramps at U.S. 69 will close overnight Aug. 15

In Overland Park, the northbound U.S. 69 ramp to Blue Valley Parkway and the Blue Valley ramp to southbound U.S. 69 will fully close to traffic starting at 8 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 15. The ramps will reopen by 6 a.m. Friday, Aug. 16.

This closure will allow for ramp striping and traffic operations.

During the closure, detours will not be marked. Northbound traffic may continue north on U.S. 69 to the College Boulevard exit; southbound traffic may utilize Metcalf Avenue to 135th Street.

All work is weather dependent and subject to change. These temporary closures are part of the Kansas Department of Transportation's U.S. 69 expansion project (69Express).

The 69Express project includes reconstruction of U.S. 69, widening the highway with added express lanes – one in each direction between 151st and 103rd Streets – and interchange improvements at U.S. 69/167th Street in Overland Park.
