



## **I-435/southbound U.S. 69 ramp will close overnight Sept. 27 in Overland Park**

The I-435 to southbound U.S. 69 ramp in Overland Park will be **fully closed to traffic** beginning at 7 p.m. Friday, Sept. 27. The ramp will reopen Saturday, Sept. 28 at 10 a.m. The closure allows construction of a temporary ramp connection.

During the same timeframe, additional adjoining ramps will be closed, as well. **The ramps and their detours are as follows.**

### **Westbound I-435 ramp to southbound U.S. 69**

- A marked detour will direct traffic to 95th Street

### **Eastbound I-435 ramp to southbound U.S. 69**

- A marked detour will direct eastbound I-435 traffic to the northbound U.S. 69 loop ramp and then to 95th Street

### **103rd Street ramp to southbound U.S. 69**

- A marked detour will direct eastbound 103rd Street traffic to the northbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp and then to 95th Street
- A marked detour will direct westbound 103rd Street traffic to Quivira and then to 95th Street

### **College Blvd. ramp to southbound U.S. 69**

- No marked detour, but eastbound College Blvd. traffic will be directed to Antioch and then south to 135th Street
- No marked detour, but westbound College Blvd. traffic will be directed to Quivira and then south to 135th Street

The work is part of the KDOT U.S. 69 Expansion Project (69Express). All scheduled project work is weather permitting and subject to change.

The 69Express project includes reconstruction of U.S. 69, widening the highway with added express lanes – one in each direction between 151st and 103rd Streets – and interchange improvements at U.S. 69/167th Street in Overland Park.
