



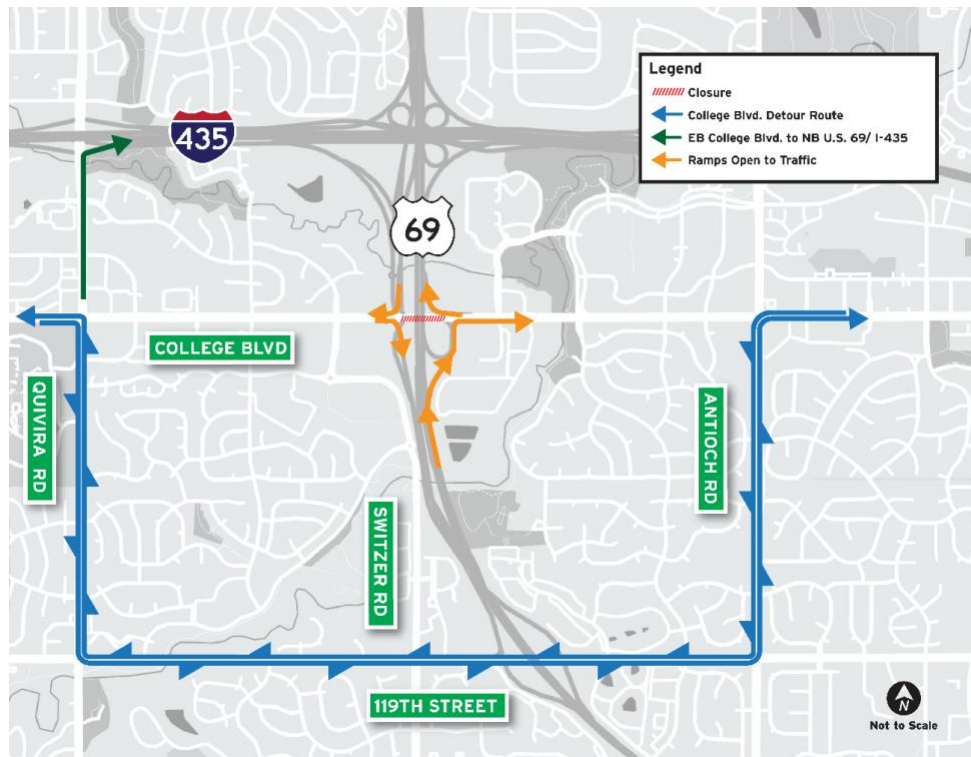
Full closure of College Blvd. at U.S. 69 scheduled weekend of Oct. 25 in Overland Park

Eastbound and westbound College Blvd. will be **fully closed** to traffic beginning Friday, Oct. 25 at 7 p.m. and will reopen by 6 a.m. Monday, Oct. 28. The closure is for bridge demolition.

During the closure, traffic will be directed to detour as follows:

- **Westbound College Blvd. traffic will be directed to turn left on Antioch Road. Take Antioch Road south to 119th Street, then turn right. Take 119th Street west to Quivira Road. Turn right on Quivira Road, drive north to College Blvd. and then turn left.**
- **Eastbound College Blvd. traffic will be directed to turn right on Quivira Road. Take Quivira Road south to 119th Street, then turn left. Take 119th Street east to Antioch Road. Turn left on Antioch Road, drive north to College Blvd. and then turn right.**
- **Eastbound College Blvd. to northbound U.S. 69/I-435 traffic will be directed to Quivira Road. Drive north on Quivira Road and utilize the eastbound I-435/U.S. 69 entrance ramp.**



All work is weather dependent and subject to change. This temporary closure is part of the Kansas Department of Transportation's U.S. 69 expansion project (69Express).

The 69Express project includes reconstruction of U.S. 69, widening the highway with added express lanes – one in each direction between 151st and 103rd Streets – and interchange improvements at U.S. 69/167th Street in Overland Park.
