I-435 eastbound and westbound full overnight closures scheduled Nov. 6 and 7 in Johnson County

Westbound I-435 from Quivira Road to Antioch Road in Johnson County will be **fully closed to traffic** beginning at 7 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 6. Ramps for westbound I-435 to southbound U.S. 69 and northbound U.S. 69 to westbound I-435 also will be **fully closed**. All lanes and ramps will reopen by Thursday, Nov. 7 at 6 a.m.

Eastbound I-435 from Quivira Road to Antioch Road in Johnson County will be **fully closed to traffic** beginning at 7 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 7. The ramp for eastbound I-435 to northbound U.S. 69 will be **fully closed**. All lanes and ramps will reopen by Friday, Nov. 8 at 6 a.m.

These temporary closures are necessary for girder setting on the southbound U.S. 69 bridge over I-435. The work is part of the KDOT U.S. 69 Expansion Project (69Express). All scheduled project work is weather permitting and subject to change.

During the closure, detours will be marked as follows:

Westbound I-435 Traffic:

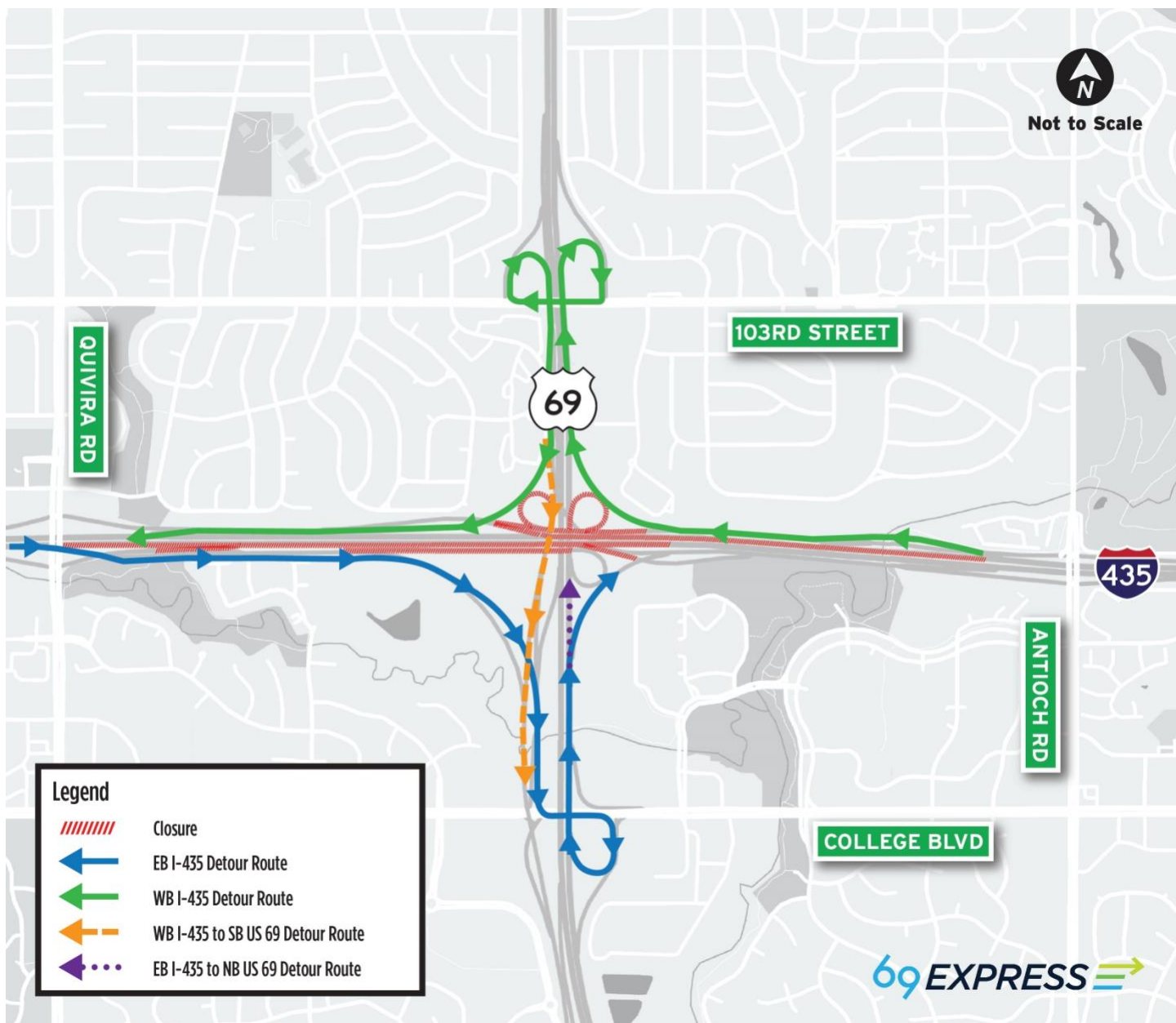
- Travel westbound I-435 to the northbound U.S. 69 ramp
- Take northbound U.S. 69 to the 103rd Street exit ramp
- Drive west along 103rd Street
- Use the 103rd Street to southbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp
- Head south on U.S. 69 to use the westbound I-435 ramp
- Continue westbound on I-435

Eastbound I-435 Traffic:

- Travel eastbound I-435 to the southbound U.S. 69 ramp
- Take southbound U.S. 69 to the College Boulevard exit ramp

- From College Boulevard, use the northbound U.S. 69 entrance ramp
- Head north on U.S. 69 to use the eastbound I-435 ramp
- Continue eastbound on I-435

Map below shows closure location marked in red and detour routes marked in blue, green, orange and purple.



The 69Express project includes reconstruction of U.S. 69, widening the highway with added express lanes – one in each direction between 151st and 103rd Streets – and interchange improvements at U.S. 69/167th Street in Overland Park.
